Length of exchange	Minimum 4 nights away	
Ratio of staff to pupils	At least legal minimum (1:5 under age 12, or 1:10 for age 12 and above)	
Child Protection/Health &	Appropriate standards met, included as checklist in grant

Disadvantage	School (or group of exchange pupils) has significant level of pupil premium numbers. Or, where appropriate, disadvantage shown through other nationally recognized standards (Opportunity Areas, Index Multiple deprivation, special needs etc.).
