

Student Week Calculation:

How to calculate your banding for the purposes of the Scheme

Updated 25 October 2024

The definition of a student week, as devised by English UK, and used by the British Council for invoicing purposes is as follows:

One (1) student undergoing at least ten (10) hours* of tuition per week. For the avoidance of doubt, any week in which a student undergoes less than ten (10) hours shall be classed as part-time and counted as half (0.5) of a student week.

*Equivalent to 600 minutes

Use this definition to indicate to the Accreditation Unit whether you are:

<u>Band A (less than 250 student weeks per year)</u> <u>Band B (between 200 – 500 student weeks per year)</u> <u>Band C (over 500 – 2,000 student weeks per year)</u> <u>Band D (over 2k –5k student weeks per year)</u> <u>Band E (over 5k – 10k student weeks per year)</u> <u>Band F (over 10k – 20k student weeks per year)</u> <u>Band G (over 20k student weeks per year)</u>

If you are still unclear on your banding, the following example may help:

Course A: 10 students x 15 hours per week for 8 weeks. $10 \times 8 = 80$ student weeks.

Course B: 20 students x 12 hours per week for 10 weeks. 20 x 10 = 200 student weeks.

Course C: 5 students x 7 hours per week for 4 weeks = No student weeks.

Course D: 5 students x 10 hours per week for 2 weeks = 10 student weeks.

TOTAL STUDENT WEEKS FOR THIS PERIOD = 290

Additional notes:

- If a student is on two or more <u>consecutive</u> courses (perhaps with a gap between studies) the total student weeks are calculated (i.e. the student should be counted separately for each course). However, for any weeks in which courses are <u>concurrent</u> then the student should only be counted once).
- Off-site work placements can be excluded from the student week calculation as they are not covered by the Scheme.
